CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

5.1 Conclusion

The purpose of this research to know the correlation between listening ability and pronunciation ability. To find it, the researcher conducted try out and test in listening and pronunciation. In analyzing data, the researcher used Correlate - Bivariate. It used to know the correlation between listening and pronunciation ability. Based on the result and the discussion, the researcher can conclude that:

1. The calculation of Rank Spearman discovers relationship (r) value is 0.336. It shows that there is positive and medium correlation between listening ability and pronunciation ability of 8th grade students at SMP Islam Manbaul Ulum Gresik. It means that between listening ability and pronunciation ability have contribution.
2. There is significant correlation ($\text{sig.} = 0.060$) between listening ability and pronunciation ability of 8th grade students at SMP Islam Manbaul Ulum Gresik. It means that the correlation between listening ability and pronunciation ability is important and noticeable. So, listening is as important as pronunciation.

5.2 Suggestion

From the research finding and research conclusion above, some suggestions are delivered:

- a. For the teachers, they can more improve the model of teaching in listening and pronunciation ability of the students. So that, the students can be a good listener and speaker.
- b. For the students, the researcher suggests that the students more improve their skill in English.
