CHAPTER I INTRODUCTION

This chapter consists of background of the study, statement of the problem, purpose of the study, significance of the study, definition of key terms.

1.1. Background of The Study

Speaking is an important skill to make the students capable of using English for communication. It is purpose to train the student's ability in language communication. That is why the students have to be able to speak up and deliver their ideas in order to reach the purpose of communicative language teaching.

Teaching speaking is the activity to help the students understand how they practice a communication by using English as a foreign language. Therefore, learning speaking is the way to understand how we can speak with other people fluently by using language. The students need to learn speaking as one of the skills in learning English as a foreign language. They use it to communicate in the real life.

Need analysis is very important to be applied for students who learn

English. Every student has different needs depending on their field. It is important

started on 2nd semester. It is because in 1st semester they must acquire pronunciation practice as the basic of speaking.

Richterich and Chancerell (1987) said that the aim of need analysis is not only to identify elements but also establish relative importance. The purpose of need analysis is not only to know the students' need, but also to give the input for the teacher as the consideration to make the suitable material based on their need.

1.2. Purposes of The Study

Based on the problem statement above, researcher decides the purposes of this study are to investigate the student's need on Speaking III, the learning need on Speaking III, and the target need on Speaking III.

1.3. Significances of the study

This study is very important and useful for teacher, the students of Speaking III, and the next researcher. Moreover, this research also can be able to give contribution to create syllabus,

help teacher to teach effective and, help learners to learn well and get better result on the next lecturer in speaking subject because it related to their need.

1.4. Definition of Key Terms

To lead this study understandable, it is compulsory to explain the key terms of this study.

Need analysis is set of tools, techniques and procedures for determining the language content and learning process for specified groups and learners (Numan, D.: 1999).

Target needs are understood as what the learner need in target of situation (Hutchinson, T. and Waters, A.: 1987 p.55). Target situation is the situation that the students have during they learn. Are they're learn for study, work, training or the combination, etc.

Learning needs are the learner needs to do in order to learn (Hutchinson, T. and Waters, A.: 1987 p.62).

Speaking is able to communicate in a specified language (Ask Oxford, 2007). Speaking III is the subject that applied for the students on the fourth semester of English Education Department at Muhammadiyah University of Gresik.
