

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSIONS AND SUGGESTIONS

Based on the findings and discussion, in chapter 5 the researcher presents the conclusions of the study and provides some suggestions. The results of the findings and discussion are summarized as follows:

5.1 Conclusions

Based on the result of the study, it can be drawn conclusion that students reading interest on short story has good potential for increasing their translation ability. There is a positive correlation between students' reading interest on short story and students' translation ability. Thus, reading interest on short story support students' translation ability.

5.2 Suggestions

1. For Students

The eighth-grade students of SMPIT Al-Ibrah should read lots of English texts that make them interested in raising student interest in reading through fiction (short stories, novels, magazines, comics, etc) or non-fiction (textbooks, journals, science book, etc) which can improve their translation ability in translating English text into Indonesian.

2. For English Teacher

English teachers should build students' interest in reading. To build students' interest in reading, teachers must consider the factors that can influence students' reading interest. Extensive reading is one of the ways that students enjoy reading, one of which is reading short stories.

3. For Next Researcher

Researcher hope that there will be further researchers who conduct research which more deeply observed and have more samples with large population area so that they can provide more complete findings and information for readers.
