You can find your paper with the key problems indicated in comments. Also, the paper has been copy-edited and formatted according to our Journal standards. Please address the issues in comments as well as proofread the text by adding/deleting text with THE TRACK CHANGES MODE on. Please note that only those issues that show up as tracked will be included in our version. Most importantly, all the requests for missing data must be addressed and supplied. If you wish to have your paper published in the January issue of TEwT, we would have to receive your paper within 4 days maximum, by January 26.
