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## **ABSTRACT**

The students' perception toward implementing Blended Learning Method in English Language Teaching (ELT) at the forth semester students English Department Fatoni University (A descriptive Qualitative Research). (Supervised by Slamet Asari and Ulfatul Ma'rifah). A Thesis of English Department, Faculty of Teacher Training and Education, Muhammadiyah Gresik University.

The purpose of this study was to learn how students felt about the Blended Learning Method's implementation in English Language Teaching (ELT) at the fourth semester of English Department students at Fatoni University as well as how the method benefited the students.

In this study, a closed-ended questionnaire and focus group discussions were used to collect data over the course of one month utilizing a descriptive methodology. Purposive sampling was used to collect the data from one class of 21 students from the fourth semester to concentrate group conversation. The scores from the closed-ended questionnaire were converted into percentages to be examined and were put into descriptions to determine the students' perception.
